





## Recommendations for paper

Release: September 2010

### General

Please use premium quality absorbent paper!

Paper size folded should be between 240mm und 250mm width and between 100mm und 115mm depth.

<b>Fold Name</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Illustration</b>	<b>Pros and Cons</b>
<p>C-fold arranged in tiers</p> <p>Recommended for <u>under-counter</u> paper towel dispensers</p>	<p>First paper towels are folded centrally. Then both sides are folded inwards (to a „C“). The paper towels are lying on each other separately.</p>		<p>+ large paper size</p> <p>- paper towel must be unfolded manually after withdrawal.</p>
<p>V-fold arranged in zigzag</p> <p>Recommended for <u>surface- and flush-mounted</u> paper towel dispensers</p>	<p>Paper towel is folded in the middle once (to a “V”). Towels are lying into each other.</p>		<p>+ Low acquisition costs</p> <p>- small paper size</p>
<p>Z-fold arranged in zigzag “Interfold” “Non Stop”</p> <p>Recommended for <u>surface- and flush-mounted</u> paper towel dispensers</p>	<p>Paper towel is folded twice (to a “Z”). Towels are lying into each other.</p>		<p>+ Larger paper size comparing to V-fold</p> <p>- High consumption due to “Non Stop”</p>
<p>W-fold arranged in zigzag “Interfold” “One stop”</p> <p>Recommended for <u>surface- and flush-mounted</u> paper towel dispensers</p>	<p>Paper towels are lying in two parallel rows each three times folded (to a “W”). Each paper towels is joined to the next with a perforated tear-off part (“One stop”). After tear-off of the first towel of row one the lowest towel of the second row is looking out of the bottom of the dispenser.</p>		<p>+ Large paper size</p> <p>+ Towel is completely unfolded after withdrawal</p> <p>+ Low consumption</p> <p>- some higher acquisition costs</p> <p>- nearly no standard paper sizes</p>
